



 With the handle of the Atom Clamp facing you, loosen the clamp by turning the handle counterclockwise.




 Identify the male thread on the item you wish to mount to the Atom Clamp, and match it up with the corresponding 3/8" or 1/4" female thread on the Atom Clamp. Mount the item by screwing it in clockwise until it is secure.



Set the jaw grip of the Atom Clamp around the surface to which you want to mount it, and tighten the clamp by turning the handle clockwise.

Repositioning the Handle



 To reposition the handle without loosening or tightening the clamp, hold the body of the Atom Clamp steady with one hand.

- Using your other hand to hold onto the base of the handle, pull the handle away from the body of the Atom Clamp.
- While still pulling the handle away from the body of the clamp, rotate the handle to the desired position and then release.

Note: Make sure everything is secure before proceeding.
