Introduction

Thank you for choosing Auray.

Congratulations on your purchase of the Auray RF-GN-10 Reflection Filter with Gooseneck.

Designed for use in studios, acoustically untreated rooms, and desktop recording, the RF-GN-10 absorbs and diffuses external noise and acoustic reflections to improve the quality of both vocal and instrumental tracks. It attaches directly onto a mic stand and, set behind the microphone, provides isolation when recording vocals, drums, pianos, or practically any acoustic instrument.

The RF-GN-10's ten-inch profile allows it to fit into tight spaces where large reflection filters are impractical. The filter features high-density acoustic foam for attenuating room ambience and a perforated aluminum shield that prevents sound from reflecting back into the microphone. The heavy-duty, 1/2" gooseneck provides precise positioning of the filter to achieve optimum results, further ensuring a dry and close sound that provides cleaner tracks. A high-quality metal alloy design makes the RF-GN-10 a sturdy, lightweight, and portable asset in any studio.

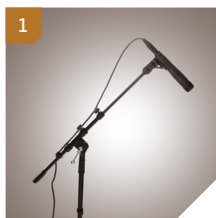

Instructions

Setting up the RF-GN-10

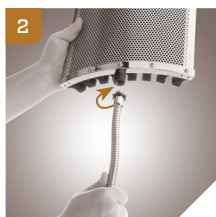
1. First, set up your microphone by placing it into the shock mount or mic clip and adjusting the mic stand to the desired height.

2. Attach the gooseneck to the filter by screwing the gooseneck's threaded post into the threaded socket of the filter until it is tight.

3. Loosen the tightening screw on the gooseneck, and fit the clamp onto the shaft of the mic stand, or the boom arm of the mic stand. Tighten the screw until the RF-GN-10 is securely in place.

4. Position the shield so that it is directly behind the microphone. Adjust the distance between the filter and microphone for optimum results.
