# Reflector Panel INSTRUCTIONS

*Light stand not included  
unless purchased as a kit.*

# Introduction

Congratulations on your purchase of an Impact Reflector Panel. The reflector materials are reversible gold/silver and black/white. The rotating/tilting bracket can hold the reflector in horizontal or vertical position at any angle. The bracket's tilt locks with a geared tooth locking mechanism and floating lever. The Impact Reflector Panel is compact and lightweight, while being quick and easy to set up.

Please follow these instructions to assemble your Impact Reflector Panel.

There are four parts to your Impact Reflector Panel contents:

- Mounting bracket with flex rod adapter
- Two reversible reflector fabrics
- Four flex rods
- Carry bag



This instructions in this manual use an RP-2839 Reflector Panel to demonstrate assembly and break-down. The RP-3570 Reflector Panel assembles by the same method. All photos in this manual are for illustration purposes only. Light stands are not included with Impact Reflector Panels unless purchased as a kit.

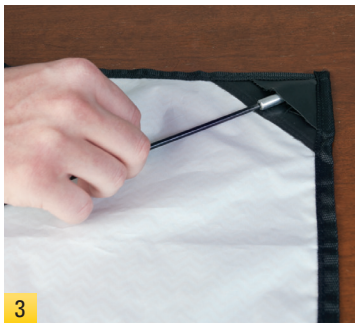
# Assembly Instructions



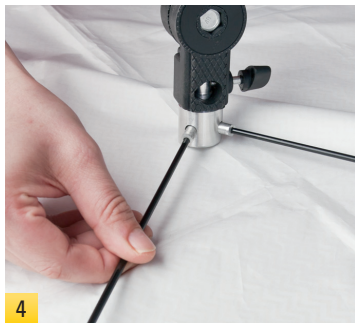
The reflector material is reversible. Place the side you wish to use as a reflector face down on a flat, horizontal surface. Place the mounting bracket in the center.



Insert one of the ends into one of the rod locating holes on the bracket head.



Insert the other end of the flex rod into a pocket in the corner of the reflector.



Insert a second flex rod into a rod locating hole on the bracket head next to where you placed the first flex rod.



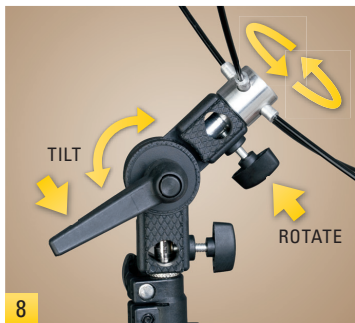
**5** Insert the other end of the flex rod into the nearest pocket on the reflector material.



**6** Without allowing the first two flex rods to become disengaged, insert the third and fourth flex rods. The rods will bend naturally into position.



**7** Your Reflector Panel is ready to be mounted on a light stand, boom or super clamp. Be sure to stabilize your setup with a sandbag or other weight.



**8** Unlock the floating lever to release the tilt mechanism and tilt the reflector into its desired position. Unlock the thumb screw to rotate the reflector into a new position.

# Disassembly Instructions

1. Unmount the Reflector Panel from its light stand or other support system.
2. Release one of the flex rods. Begin by bending it free of the pocket in the reflector fabric.
3. After the first flex rod is released, the Reflector Panel will collapse on its own and the rest of the flex rods will be easy to remove.
4. Return all Reflector Panel items to their carry bag.



## Recommended Accessories



### Impact Light Stand

The Impact LS-6B Light Stand is one of the most economical light stands available. It extends to a maximum height of 6 ft, and has a standard 5/8" stud on top with a 1/4"-20 thread.



### Impact Super Clamp

The Impact Super Clamp with Standard Stud has strong jaws that can clamp on flat surfaces or tubes from 1/2 to 2-1/8 inches in diameter. The clamp includes a standard (5/8") stud that will accept the Impact Reflector Panel or many other light fixtures and accessories.



### Impact Sandbags

Impact Sandbags come in a variety of shapes, weights, and are either black or orange. They are used for anchoring the bases of light stands and set walls. The saddle-style sandbags have two wings so they can be draped over light stand legs. Each side of the bag has a hand strap for easy handling and hanging on hooks. The outer shell is water resistant, heavy-duty cordura nylon. Impact Sandbags can be purchased pre-filled or empty.
