
for Nikon 14-24mm f/2.8 G AF-S lens

#### Thank you for choosing Sensei Pro

The FH-150-14M filter holder allows the use of standard 150 mm (5.9") 2 mm thick filters with Nikon's 14-24mm f/2.8 lens. It quickly and easily mounts onto the lens and is capable of holding two filters simultaneously. It can be adapted to include an additional slot for a third filter with the included film clips. The holder can smoothly rotate a full 360° allowing use of filters that are most effective with adjustable positioning. Backlighting will not produce flare or glare due to our innovative gapless design that leaves less than a 2 mm space between the filter and filter holder. Aircraft aluminum construction provides durability, and silicon friction strips secure the lens. Together they ensure flawless operation.




## Instructions



#### Mounting the Filter Holder

1. Insert the mounting foam into the holder. If it doesn't slide into the holder easily, turn the foam 1/4 turn for the proper orientation.



- 2. Place the filter holder on a flat surface so that it's resting on the foam and the lens mount is facing up.
- 3. Loosen the locking knobs on either side of the holder.



4. With the lens holder still on the flat surface, place the lens down into the holder. Make sure the holder and the lens are aligned by lining up the top of the lens and the Sensei Pro logo.



5. Securely tighten the two locking knobs simultaneously. Once the knobs are secure, remove the mounting foam.


Note: To ensure the lens is centered in the holder, make sure the locking knobs are applying equal tension to the lens on either side



6. Install a filter into the holder by sliding it into position between the film clips. Due to the snug fit, the filter may have to be slightly jiggled to glide into the clips.


Note: Do not use excessive force that can damage the filter or the holder.

Once the filter is installed, the filter can be adjusted for optimum performance by sliding it up and down or rotating it.




#### Adding a Third Filter


1. Using a 5/64 flathead screwdriver, carefully remove the screws from the film clips.




2. Remove the top clips and insert the extra film clips by placing them under the top clips.



3. Make sure the new clips are oriented similarly to the other clips so that the curve of the clips is bending away from the base.



4. Replace the top clips by placing them on top of the newly added clips. As in the previous step, make sure the curve is oriented similarly with the other clips.



5. Replace and securely screw in the clip screws. If it is taking too much effort to insert a filter, check the orientation of the clips to make sure they are all curving in the same direction.

*Note: At the 45° rotation, vignetting will be encountered when using three filters.*
