THE WATSON 4-HOUR RAPID BATTERY CHARGER'S FEATURES INCLUDE:



1. Universal Power Supply -100-240V AC input voltage



 Multiple Charging Circuits -Allows you to charge two or four AA/AAA size nickel-metal hydride or nickel-cadmium batteries.



 Automatic Charge Current Selection -Automatically selects the best charging current for each battery size.



 Automatic Shut-Off -A special circuit senses when battery is fully charged.



 Reverse Polarity Protection-Protects your batteries and the charger against incorrectly installed batteries.



 Safety Timer Shut-Off -Turns off the charger to prevent overcharging batteries.



 Short Circuiting Protection -Protects the charger and batteries from short circuits.



 Over-Current Protection -Protects the charger from defective or shorted batteries.



 Simultaneous Charging -Patented technology charges AA and AAA size batteries simultaneously.

CHARGING OPERATION AA & AAA BATTERIES:

- Insert 2 or 4 AA or AAANi-CD or Ni-MH batteries into battery chambers, oriented according to the polarity symbols (+ or -) that are marked inside each chamber.
- Pull out the flat AC plug 90 degrees, and plug into a standard AC outlet.
- The charging indictor lights will flash before charging, then go solid red while charging.
 - When the batteries are fully charged, the lights will go solid green.
 - When you are finished charging the batteries, remove the flat AC plug from the AC outlet.

- It is normal for the batteries to become warm while charging.
- Charge batteries in temperatures between 32°F and 113°F (0°C and 45°C). Cold batteries cannot charge fully. If they are too warm, the batteries can lose their capacity to recharge.
- Do not charge batteries other than those listed in this manual, and do not use procedures other than those described in this manual.

Note: If two level indicators are flashing, it is an indication that at least one of the batteries needs to be replaced.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

- Charge only Ni-CD or Ni-MH batteries with this charger. Other types of batteries can burst, causing personal injury and damage.
