




# Thank you for choosing Xuma.

The Xuma IP-KCO1 Bluetooth Keyboard Case features a Bluetooth keyboard with a magnetized surface that attaches to the included hard-shell iPhone 5 case. The case mounts to the keyboard in portrait or landscape orientation, and the keyboard conveniently stores under the case when not in use. The keyboard recharges via a USB charging plate. It boasts an ultraslim design and three shortcut keys for optimal functionality.



Here are the basic instructions to guide you through the setup and synchronization process.

#### Precautions

- Please read and follow these instructions and keep this manual in a safe place.
- 2. Keep this product away from water and all flammable gases or liquids.
- 3. Do not attempt to disassemble or repair this product.
  - 4. Clean this product with only a soft, dry cloth.
  - 5. All photos are for illustrative purposes only.

- Use the included USB. charging cable to connect the charging plate to a USB power source (not included). The charging LED will glow when the plate is connected to a power source.
- 2. Match up the charging contacts on the rear of the keyboard with the charging contacts inside the charging plate, and place the keyboard inside the plate. The CHARGE LED on the keyboard will glow when the unit is charging, and will turn off when charging is complete.



### **Getting Started**

- Insert your iPhone into the case so your iPhone's external controls fit into the corresponding openings in the case.
- 2. Push down on the other side of the iPhone so it locks into the case.

The keyboard and the case attach via their magnetic surfaces, and can be used in landscape and portrait orientations. For landscape orientation, make sure the camera openings on the case and the keyboard are aligned (Figure 1).

For portrait orientation, align the bottom of the case with the dotted line on the keyboard's magnetic surface (Figure 2).





#### Pairing Up the Keyboard

- Turn on the keyboard by pressing and holding the power switch until the Bluetooth light glows. It will glow, turn off, and then blink rapidly until paired.
- On your iPhone, select Settings → Bluetooth (Figure 3).
- Select ON to activate the iPhone's Bluetooth feature. The iPhone will automatically search for available Bluetooth devices.
- Select "Bluetooth keyboard for iPhone 5" from the list of discovered Bluetooth devices (Figure 4).



#### Turning off the keyboard, Reconnecting, and Sleep Mode

To turn off the keyboard, press and hold the power key until the Bluetooth LED blinks. The keyboard will turn off and disconnect from your iPhone.

To reconnect the keyboard, press and hold the power key until the Bluetooth LED glows. The keyboard will turn on and reconnect with your iPhone.

When the keyboard is inactive for several minutes, it will enter sleep mode in order to conserve battery power. Press any key to wake up the keyboard.

#### **Shortcut Keys**

The shortcut keys are shortcuts to various functions on your iPhone. They are located in the top row, on the 5, 6, and 7 keys. Press Fn + the key to access the shortcut.

# Troubleshooting

Following are a few common problems that may arise during the operation of your Bluetooth Keyboard Case, and basic troubleshooting solutions to avoid them.

Problem	Solution
The keyboard does not respond.	Make sure that the wireless keyboard is turned on and paired up, and that the battery is charged.
The wireless keyboard is not pairing up with the iPhone.	Make sure that the wireless keyboard and the iPhone are turned on, and that their batteries are charged.
	Make sure the wireless keyboard is within operating distance of the iPhone (33 feet or 10 meters).
	Make sure the iPhone's Bluetooth setting is turned on.
	Make sure to select Bluetooth Keyboard for iPhone 5 on the iPhone's list of discovered Bluetooth devices.

#### ONE-YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY
